



## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Conserve Oilfield Services Ltd is a professional and environmentally aware organisation which acknowledges the impact that our operations may potentially have on the environment. Our objective is to minimise any impact on the environment by:

- Preventing pollution, reducing waste and ensuring that, wherever practicable, measures are implemented to protect and preserve natural habitats, flora and fauna

We will take all practical steps to ensure that potential hazards and risks to the environment are identified and that suitable and effective preventive control measures are implemented. All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfil the requirements of this Policy.

The Managing Director has overall responsibility for all environmental matters. The operation of this Policy and the associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed on a regular basis. This policy has been endorsed by the Managing Director who gives his full support to its implementation.
